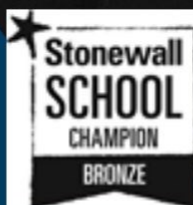

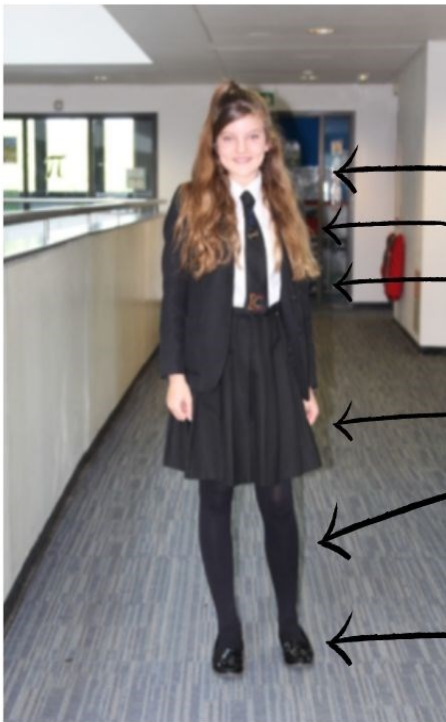
QUESTIONS ABOUT THE FIRST DAY



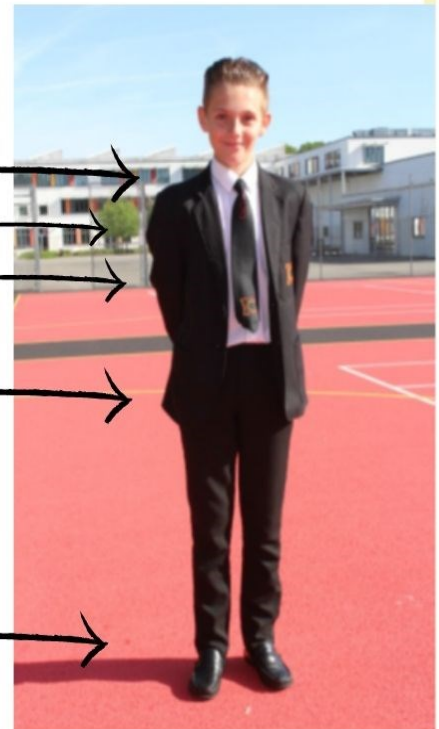
WHERE WILL I GO?

ABOUT MY CLASS



DO I GO STRAIGHT TO MY FIRST LESSON?

No you go to your mentor room to register.

WHAT IS A MENTOR GROUP?

This is the group of students you will be with. You will register together first thing in the morning and do your lessons together for the first term. During mentor time you have an 'activity' of the day. Your mentor will make sure that you are ready for the day.

DO YOU GIVE REWARDS OUT FOR GOOD EFFORT?

These are called R points (reward points). They range from R1 to R5 . At the end of the term reward parties and trips are held for students that have earned enough points.

WILL I BE WITH MY FRIENDS?

We will try and put you in a mentor group with others that you may know.



QUESTIONS ABOUT LEARNING



1.WHO WILL I SIT NEXT TO?

Each class has a seating plan and you will be told where to sit. You will sit in this seat every time you are in that class.

2. HOW MANY STUDENTS ARE IN MY CLASS?

Between 22-30 students.

3. WILL I GET SET HOMEWORK?

Yes you can view your homework on Go4Schools

4. WILL I BE GIVEN A PEN?

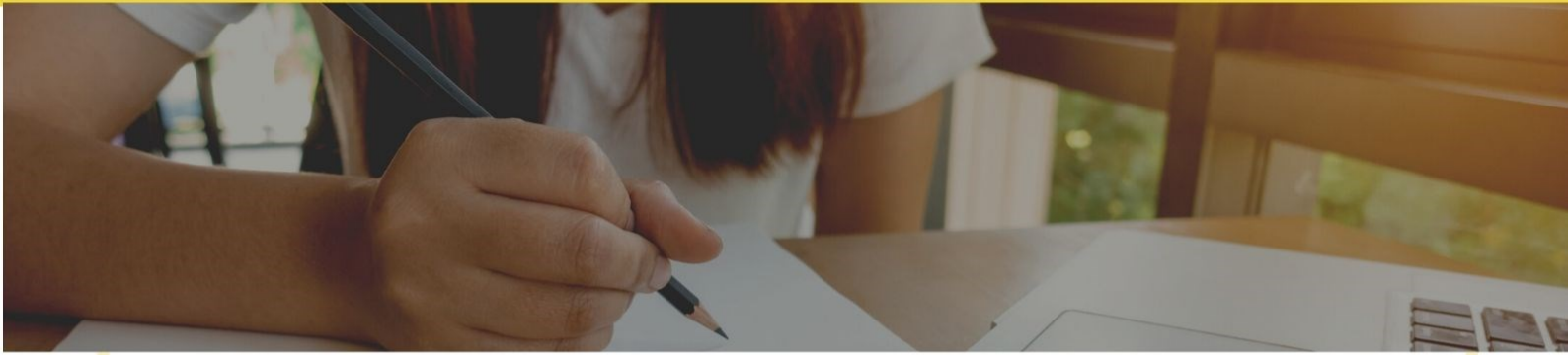
No, you will need to bring in your own equipment

QUESTIONS ABOUT LUNCH TIME



DO I NEED TO BRING MONEY IN?

Yes you can do or parents/carers can put money onto the system. When students start at ICC parents/carers will be provided with details on how to register to make on-line payments through ParentPay <https://www.parentpay.com/>. Students will be shown what to do about getting your lunch on the first day.

HOW LONG IS BREAK & LUNCH TIME?

Break is at 10:55 for 15mins

Lunch is at 1:15 for 40mins

WHERE CAN I EAT?

You can eat your lunch indoors on the ground floor, the canteen or out in the courtyard.

WHAT CAN I DO AT LUNCH TIME?

You can play with friends or use the Learning Resource Centre (Library) to read or do homework.

ARE THERE CLUBS AT LUNCH TIME?

Yes there are a variety of clubs at lunchtime which you will be told about.



GENERAL QUESTIONS



CAN I BRING MY PHONE IN?

Phones can be brought in if they are necessary for journeys to and from school but this needs to be turned off in your bag or locker.

WHO DO I TALK TO IF I HAVE ANY PROBLEMS?

You can talk to any member of staff. The main people will be your mentor, progress leader and pastoral manager.

WHERE DO I GO IF I'VE HURT MYSELF OR FEEL UNWELL?

You can tell a member of staff who will arrange for you to get taken to the medical room.

CAN YOU GO TO THE TOILET IN LESSON?

Your year group toilets will be open during break and lunch time for you. If it's an emergency you may ask your teacher and the toilets by medical will be open. If you have a medical condition you can let your progress leader know and they will issue you with a medical toilet card if you need the toilets on a regular basis.

DO I HAVE TO PAY FOR CLUBS?

DO I NEED MY PE KIT EVERYDAY?

No only on the days you have PE. For your PE kit you will need an ICC Red Polo shirt/black shirt (Dance), black shorts or leggings, black or white socks, suitable trainers.

CHECKLIST FOR THE FIRST DAY

- Pencil case including pen, green pen, pencil, sharpener, rubber, ruler, calculator, & protractor

- Catering 1. Bring money in to pay for lunch
2. Bring a healthy packed lunch. Crisps, sugary snack, or fizzy snacks are **NOT** permitted
- Practice walking/ taking the bus to school
